General Comments

A reach-in refrigerator behind the serving line was not working properly. No foods were being stored here. Staff stated a work order has been placed for repair. Please ensure this is repaired.

Handwash sink reached 157F. This could be turned down so that it keeps a minimum of 100F but not so hot it that could scald skin.

No other violations observed.
